assover (Pesach) is an appointed time of remembrance. We recall the exodus from Egypt, when God fulfilled His word to return the Israelites to the Promised Land. Today we see that He is carrying out a second miraculous exodus.

In the last seventy-plus years, the Jewish population of Israel has grown from 600,000 to over six million. Clearly, now is the appointed time for the second great exodus. Millions have returned, and the desert is blooming (Isaiah 35:1). This testimony is embedded in our own experience of God's faithfulness.

As we mentioned in our previous newsletter, God has commanded us to partner with Him and the Jewish people in this great second exodus, centering in New York City (NYC). We also recall that to love, stand with, and support the Jewish people is a biblical command: "Comfort, comfort my people, says your God." Isaiah 40:1 NKJV

KEY WORDS

Aliyah is the word for the immigration of Jewish people from the Diaspora to the Land of Israel. The word in Hebrew means ascent and is defined as 'going up' – progressing towards Jerusalem.

Olim means Jewish immigrants to Israel – those making Aliyah. In the singular, a male immigrant is called an oleh and a female immigrant an olah. Potential Olim are those our teams contact and encourage to make Aliyah.





he Lord is gathering His sons and daughters back from the West one by one. Moving deeper into the New York City area to assist with Aliyah has been a challenge, but in the three years we have been doing this an increasing number of Olim have reached out to us for help.

Talia was one I was able to help. Here she tells of the heart-changing step that brought her to decide to return home to Israel:

I have [been] to Israel four times and every time was more meaningful than the last. The first time I went with my family when I was 12. I remember going to the Western Wall with my mom. After a few minutes I looked up and she was crying. I was so confused thinking to myself this was just a wall. When I asked her why she was crying she just said, "You'll understand when you're older."

Eight years later I went to the Western Wall again but this time by myself. As soon as I approached the wall I started to cry. It finally hit me. This was not just a wall. The Wall represented the perseverance of the Jews. It represented everything we have gone through. It represented hope. I called my mom that night and said "Mom, I understand now." That's when I knew I wanted to make Aliyah.

What a privilege it remains to continue to be part of this amazing work! What a blessing to accompany Talia to the airport and assist her until she passed through the gates, boarding the El Al flight that was taking her from hope to home.

With our hearts filled with God's love and excitement, we are taking up the baton to run with passion to bless and comfort our Jewish friends in a much deeper and meaningful way. Thank you; your prayers and support make a difference!

s the Lord continues to bring more Jews to the Land of Israel, new relationships are being edified with other Christian and Jewish organizations that the Lord is calling to assist. His love and care for each Olim case is shown as we participate in the provision of short-term housing while they wait for their flight confirmation, health care assistance, and the transportation of individuals and families from distant regions to complete their Aliyah interview.

The continuous prayer for the Aliyah highways in the Western Hemisphere has been fruitful. In the USA, the East Coast Hispanic churches are responding to pray and give. In Canada, prayer initiatives in British Columbia and Alberta are bringing new contacts for teaching. In Central America, Ebenezer Operation Exodus Guatemala adopted Honduras and Costa Rica to participate in prayer, in teaching the churches, and building relationships with the Jewish Communities.

More prayer is needed in response to the urgency of prophetic times. We are His hands called to bring His people home.
