hile traveling home from our son's wedding not too long ago, my wife and I met a shopkeeper near Boone, North Carolina. Sensing that he was Jewish, we started a conversation with Leo, even mentioning our efforts as Christians to help his people make *Aliyah* (immigrate to Israel). Feeling comfortable with us, he opened up and shared some of his story — a story that unfortunately is being repeated all across America.


Leo, a politically conservative Jew, told us that he and his family had lived just north of the Bay Area in California, where they began noticing an uptick in anti-Jewish sentiment in their community a few years ago. Then last year they encountered some "real heat," to the point where they realized they needed to relocate to a more Jewish-friendly part of the country for safety reasons. They chose South Florida for the time being. Leo just happened to be in North Carolina on business, allowing our paths

to cross. (I call it a divine appointment!)

He shared that people in northern California, as a whole, had become radically pro-Palestinian, viewing Israel and the Jewish people as the main culprits in destabilizing the Middle East, and hence the world. Jews were being blamed for other societal ills as well. The environment had become so toxic that it left his family no choice but to move.

This anti-Semitic worldview has gained significant traction in the most liberal regions of the US, from California and Washington on the west coast, to Minnesota and Michigan in the heartland, and to parts of New York and New England in the east. In July, Ben and Jerry's, the Vermont ice cream company known for its leftwing views, announced its support of a boycott

against Israel, refusing to sell their treats in "occupied areas" of the Jewish nation. This is only the latest example coming from the growing anti-Israel Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement spreading through corporate America.

I wish I could say that the climate for Jews in our country will improve; however, it's bound to get worse, with more hostilities and crimes against the Jewish community. The primary cause of this is the unprecedented amount of resources and propaganda committed to the anti-Jewish/anti-Israel narrative. Most of our mainstream media, universities, liberal politicians, and religious leaders are now squarely in the pro-Palestinian camp (with some of them even favoring Hamas' efforts against Israel). They have dug in their heels and are ready for a fight, confident they will win.

THIS ANTI-SEMITIC WORLDVIEW HAS GAINED SIGNIFICANT TRACTION...

So, what does this sobering reality mean for those of us who, as Christians, love the Jewish people and recognize their end-time prophetic role? We must begin by praying for them and helping them in whatever way God directs. As we assist and comfort His ancient, covenant people, we must let our light shine brightly for Jesus as a reflection of His enduring love for them. We need to stand firm in our support and be willing to suffer alongside them if necessary.

Like Leo and his family, many Jews are considering their next move. Making *Aliyah* may soon become their only option. As the son of a Croatian father who fled first from the Communists, then from the Nazis, and a

German mother who survived Hitler's regime, I pledge — with God's help — to stand with the Jewish people and against those seeking to destroy them. What will you do?


Before parting ways with Leo, I went out to the car and retrieved a copy of my book, which I signed and gave to him. He emailed me just the other day to let me know he'd begun reading it with great interest. We'll see where this goes. Pray that Leo will be sensitive to God's leading!

Prayer Points

The LORD has highlighted the importance of strengthening the infrastructure of our ministry, specifically our National Office in Buffalo, NY. He has made provisions and positioned our ministry to be ready to assist the greater numbers of *Olim*. The uncertainty and present dangers we face will most likely bring new challenges and opportunities for us to encourage and help our Jewish brothers and sisters make their journey home.

nti-Semitism is a specific prejudice against the Jews. It is an idea or behavior hostile towards a person or group just because they are Jewish. The hate may be expressed in speech, in writing, or visually. Depending on local legislation, it may be considered criminal if it progresses to hate crimes, such as vandalism and violence. All these forms are now present in Western society.

For the past ten years, anti-Semitism has been growing in the very nations that once fought the Nazis. Incidents of this are too numerous to list. On university campuses the situation is dire. Jewish students are reportedly hiding their identities. Student groups, as well as faculty, may be prejudiced. With apartheid being the heaviest accusation in their arsenal, Israel Apartheid Week is routine on many campuses.

While criticizing Israel is not always anti-Semitic, we cannot be naive. Criticism is often just a mask for anti-Semitism. In May we witnessed a conflict between Israel and Hamas. Pro-Palestinian demonstrations took place, and much of the international reporting tended to be slanted against Israel. However, in countries surrounding Israel such criticism is avoided, even though human rights are routinely abused.

Almost every nation-state in Europe is seeing an increase in the frequency and severity of anti-Semitic incidents. Vandalism has progressed to terror. The USA was previously thought to be immune to this virus. In a 2020 survey, however, sixty-three per cent of Jews reported increasing anti-Semitism in the past ten years. Fifty-four per cent had witnessed actual anti-Semitic attacks.

It is beyond tragic that seventy-five years after the liberation of Auschwitz, younger Jewish generations may be facing the same choices their ancestors faced. The Israel I know is a wonderful, miraculous country. Moving there out of a deep desire is one thing, but escaping

from rising anti-Semitism is quite another. Based on biblical accounts, the consequences of allowing hostile anti-Semitism in our societies will be disastrous to ourselves. Throughout history, the blessings of God have left areas where this ancient hatred was allowed to reign.


In terms of our Jewish communities, it is likely that *Aliyah* awareness will soon increase. Anti-Semitism may force choices that otherwise could be postponed. At the time of this writing, several European Jewish leaders recently expressed their worry that the fight against anti-Semitism may already be lost. We can no longer feel certain that the USA is any different. In our increasingly complex world, it may be only Israel that rests on a secure footing.

Prayer Points

- "I want you to understand this mystery...so that you will not feel proud about yourselves."
 Romans 11:25 NLT. We begin with us, the Church. Humbly pray God will remove the blindness of those in His Church ignorant of, apathetic to, or condoning of Anti-Semitism.
- "...See how my enemies torment me...Save me so I can praise You...at Jerusalem's gates..."
 Psalm 9:13-14 NLT. Pray for The LORD to deliver His people completely from the plans of the enemy through anti-Semitism.
