## THE ALIYAH CONNECTION

Inspiration sometimes comes at unexpected times. The time and place were a candlelight Christmas Eve service at a local church. Traditional hymns and carols were sung. Scriptures were read, such as the Luke 2 account of Jesus' birth and Old Testament prophecies about the coming of the Messiah.

#### The Moment of Revelation

The setting God chose to turn the light on for me happened during a reading of Isaiah 11, the description of the coming Messiah. That was the moment when I saw the unmistakable link between Advent and *Aliyah* (immigrating to Israel).

"And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, who shall stand as a banner to the people; ... It shall come to pass in that day that the Lord shall set His hand again the second time to recover the remnant of His people who are left, ... He will set up a banner for the nations, and will assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four


corners of the earth." Isaiah 11:10-12 NKJV.

Why had I not seen it so clearly before? Perhaps this revelation — this clear connection between the coming of the Messiah and Aliyah — had always been obvious to my fellow Christians. But for me on that Christmas Eve, as I sat in a dimly-lit sanctuary, holding a candle before me, the true light suddenly burst into view. Literally, "The people who were sitting in darkness (me) saw a great light, . . ." Matthew 4:16 NASB.

# ... THE RETURN OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE TO THE LAND IS AN ISSUE THAT DEMANDS OUR ATTENTION ...

#### I Should Have Known

The chances are good that at some point in my Christian experience, I had heard a Bible teacher make this connection. Given my longstanding relationship with Derek Prince and his clear,

But now, as often happened over the years with other insights into the Bible, the Lord refreshed this significant truth for me.

To explore further what He was showing me, I went back and reviewed some of Derek Prince's teaching. In a little booklet called "Why Israel?" I saw several pertinent quotes from Derek like the following one:

If we put these truths from Matthew and Zechariah together (Matthew 23:39 and Zechariah 12:10, 11), they make it clear that before the Lord returns, certain requirements have to be established. The Jewish people have to be reestablished in Jerusalem and in the Land, because the Lord Jesus is not coming back until they are.

If these words are true, the distinct connection between the first and second coming of the Messiah and the return of the Jewish people to the Land is an issue that demands our greater attention and devotion.

## THE JEWISH PEOPLE HAVE TO BE RE-ESTABLISHED IN JERUSALEM AND IN THE LAND . . .

How Should We Respond?

Perhaps one additional connecting point for us between Advent and *Aliyah* could be the familiar Christmas carol which expresses the following longing: "O come, O come, Emmanuel, and ransom captive Israel, that mourns in lowly exile here, until the Son of God appear." Are we longing for His appearance?

If the coming of the Messiah is dependent upon Jewish people returning to their beloved Israel and residing there when His return occurs, should it not be a high priority for each of us to assist somehow in the process of *Aliyah*?

If indeed the coming of the Messiah is drawing near, will you and I affirm that Advent by committing our hearts and our resources toward helping our Jewish brothers and sisters make *Aliyah*?

#### **Prayer Points**

- Thank God for His gracious gift of spiritual revelation, whether it be in an area that had been dark or an increase of depth, understanding, and activation that builds upon prior revelation.
- "I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light . . . "Ephesians 1:18a NLT. Pray that the light of the revelation of the centrality of Aliyah in relation to the Second Coming of Christ will shine brightly into the hearts of many Christians, Church leaders, and entire congregations that have been entirely ignorant of it. Stir them to active response.
- "But the path of the just is like the shining sun, that shines ever brighter unto the perfect day."
   Proverbs 4:18 NKJV. Pray that Christians who understand this revelation receive even more light and let it shine brightly through outreach to those in the dark.

## COMPASS POINTING THE EXILES TO ISRAEL

liyah is the magnetic force in God's compass, bringing His people HOME! World events and circumstances cannot stop this mighty move of God upheld by His loving kindness and faithfulness to restore Israel! American Jews are going home!

We rejoice at the statistics reported by the Israeli government's Ministry of *Aliyah* and Integration and by the Jewish Agency for Israel. Last year, over 4,000 *Olim* (Jewish immigrants) made *Aliyah* from our nation, a thirty percent increase over 2020. This was the highest annual number of *Olim* from the USA since 1973! To God be all the glory and praise!

God hates the exile of His people! As we were praying and pondering the theme and focus for this newsletter, the LORD highlighted Ezekiel 37:12 (NLT), where God prophesies to His people and says, "... I will open your graves of exile and cause you to rise again. Then, I will bring you back to the land of Israel." God's command to prophesy this scripture gave me, my wife Adrianne, and our team a more profound revelation and clarity of the urgency of the work at hand.

I believe we have entered into a new phase and depth of *Aliyah* from our nation. This holy work is of the utmost importance and priority to the LORD! There is a heightened sense of determination and commitment within many Orthodox Jewish communities that life in the USA is changing irrevocably. I want to share a headline published at the end of last year in Haaretz, an Israeli newspaper:

"Ultra-Orthodox Aliyah to Israel is

Breaking Records. Here is why: For decades, Haredim in the Diaspora rejected the notion of immigrating to Israel. No more. Now, Ultra-Orthodox American Jews see themselves as 'the next great frontier in Aliyah' and are moving to Israel in increasing numbers."

What an incredible breakthrough and answer to prayer! This is a fundamental paradigm shift in their core beliefs of who they are as a people and their view of Israel. God is removing layers of deception from their hearts, opening their eyes to their true identity as sheep of the House of Israel. God's eternal purpose is for them to live to reveal His power and proclaim His Holy Name throughout all the earth (Exodus 9:16).

## WE HAVE ENTERED INTO A NEW PHASE AND DEPTH OF *ALIYAH* . . .

The command God gave in Deuteronomy still stands today! He is calling His people back HOME – inviting them to choose life over death! "... Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! ... you will live long in the Land. .." Deuteronomy 30:19 NLT.

God has given each one of us a strong voice to bring the truth and the priority He places on the *Aliyah* of His people! Time is short! Our team at Operation Exodus USA operates with great hope as we pray and prepare for a great *Aliyah* wave this year and beyond. Will you join your voices to ours and share in your communities the importance of this mighty move of God that must take place before His coming? Do not be silent; your voice is powerful!

t all began with two verses of Scripture:
"Pray for the peace of Jerusalem . . . " (Psalm 122:6), and "I will bless those who bless you . . . " (Genesis 12:3). Those were the two verses I learned growing up in my traditional Gentile church. So every now and then, I would remember and say a prayer for Israel and the Jewish people.

He also wanted us to make an ongoing financial commitment to bless Israel each month. hat a packed verse! It is a powerful explosive that carries a triple payload: Open, Rise, and Return. It is the settled word of the Sovereign God, and it detonates through prophetic declaration.

Last year, the LORD gave the word "OPEN" to our intercessors as a prophetic declaration — to keep gates of egress from the USA and the gates of immigration into Israel open, even when they were closing to tourism and regular travel. Not only did the usual Aliyah airports in the USA remain open, but additional gates of departure such as Miami and Chicago — were established. We prayed that the hearts of the Jewish people would be opened to hear and obey His command to return to the Land. Our Aliyah Department, which interacts personally and directly with the applicants, reported an uncommon commitment to make Aliyah in increasingly unfavorable travel conditions and requirements. We were also amazed at the number of people who were (and still are) applying for assistance.

### ... GOD HAS PROMISED TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE — HE WILL OPEN THE GRAVES OF EXILE.

Now the Spirit is expanding and deepening our prophetic declaration to open by giving us a fresh revelation of the true condition of the exilic Jews. He does not mince words: "... I will open

your graves of exile . . . " (Ezekiel 37:12). He is revealing that many have become so entrenched in a false existence in exile that it goes beyond even being captive. Captives are alive. He has made provision, and we pray for those who are captive (Isaiah 49:25). Ezekiel 37:12 reveals that many are spiritually dead to their identity and destiny. But God has promised to do the impossible – He will open the graves of exile. And beyond that, He raises them up and gives them a new spirit to recognize their identity and destiny. He gives them the heart and will to walk out who they are, and He Himself returns them home.

We pray and declare the Scriptures many times, in many ways, and every time there is new life in the declaration. He continues to deepen and expand us in miraculous intercession year by year, month by month, day by day. We begin 2022 with this declaration over the Jews in exile in the USA: Graves of exile be opened, Rise to your identity and destiny, Return to your God-given Land. All for His glory!

#### Prayer Points

- " Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But with God everything is possible." Matthew 19:26 NLT. Thank, praise, and worship God that all things are possible for Him – even raising spiritually dead Jewish people in exile.
- Focus on a particular geographic area or city with a Jewish presence. Speak the Word of Lord into that area: " . . . O my people, I will open your graves of exile and cause you to rise again . . . I will bring you back to the land of Israel." Ezekiel 37:12 NLT.

Daily we hear reports of diminishing respect for human life and the effects of the spirit of hatred running rampant through many major cities in the US. The LORD is shaking His people to return home — Aliyah will rise to unprecedented numbers in the coming days!

The World Zionist Organization and The Jewish Agency for Israel recently published a report stating that thirty percent of anti-Semitic incidents worldwide in 2021 occurred in the USA. The US state with the most reported incidents was New York, followed by Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Florida, California, and Texas. The report also pointed to a rise in anti-Semitism (just one of many triggers motivating Jewish people to make Aliyah) in the ranks of academia in the US. Unfortunately, this trend will only grow in momentum!

This year, we are targeting the Church and Jewish communities with an aggressive and robust outreach program. Please join us in prayer and support as we grow the awareness and urgency of the work of Aliyah. We pray for favor and open doors to raise the banner of Alivah and share our call and mandate with local Jewish federations and community leaders. We must

build strong relationships and trust amongst our Jewish friends. We also pray for favor and open doors to meet with church leaders. We must share the truth of God's prophetic Word and His promises to restore ISRAEL — and the responsibility of the Church to carry His sons and daughters home (Isaiah 49:22).

Our team is looking forward to meeting with some of you soon at our National Headquarters in Buffalo, NY, to train and equip you to raise the banner of Aliyah and be a voice in your own backyard! We cannot do this work alone; your role and voice are crucial to this holy work! We must stand together as the LORD leads His people HOME! Our hearts are filled with God's love and gratitude for each one of you, our friends and partners!
