e have probably all been disappointed—
and perhaps disillusioned—by promises
made to us but not kept. Maybe the
other party couldn't keep them or didn't intend to.
This can become problematic if we project those
broken promises onto our understanding of God
and His Word, especially when many of God's
promises were written thousands of years ago and
we still haven't seen their fulfillment.

The difference is that God keeps His promises! We see proof of this throughout history, even when His promises seemed far-fetched. For example, Sarah laughed when the angel of the Lord said she would have a son in her old age (Genesis 18:12). And after God promised Israel deliverance from slavery, Israel was terrified when Pharaoh's army pinned them from any escape, until the sea opened a path to freedom (Exodus 14). In addition, God promised Hezekiah deliverance when Sennacherib's army of 185,000 men came to destroy Jerusalem, and the angel

of the Lord struck them down (Isaiah 38:6-7). Clearly, God has no trouble keeping His promises even when it looks improbable or — more likely — impossible.

Regarding the return of God's people to Israel, there are many people who have been faithfully believing His promises and preparing for decades for the return of Jews to Israel. We are seeing *Aliyah* gradually evolve, but not to the extent of the promises in God's Word.

At Operation Exodus USA, we are praying to challenge ourselves and our supporters to truly commit to the LORD to receive the full revelation of the "grandeur" of His end-time work — in fulfillment of all His promises to gather His people, restore the Land to them, and to redeem them. UNDERSTANDING GOD'S COVENANTAL PLANS

I gnorance breeds pride, and pride leads to blindness. Blindness in the church has created major obstacles (boulders) in the minds of many Jewish people. Most Christians are unaware of the shocking history that has been omitted from most Christian history books. The history reveals the tragic role the church played in the persecution of the Jewish people. The cross — a symbol of God's sacrificial love — was turned into a bloody sword.

This has been a major "boulder" on the Jewish people's highway to salvation and back to Israel—their Land of promise. When the influence of the early church's Jewish leaders began to diminish in Rome, Gentile Christian leaders, who were steeped in Greco/Roman translations of Scripture, were led into wrong theology. Many, if not all, were leaders, theologians, and teachers of the Word of God. They were not evil men, and they most likely did not realize the consequences of their errors in interpreting Scripture, particularly with respect to God's irrevocable promises to the Jewish people and the future nation of Israel.

The historic church often embraced replacement theology — the belief that Christ nullified the original promises made by God to the children of Israel, and that Israel is no longer God's chosen covenant people. Thankfully, there has always been a small remnant of people who have loved and blessed the Jewish people, even when it was not popular to do so. The error of replacement theology played a key role in the slaughter of countless Jews during the crusades, inquisitions, pogroms, and even the Holocaust. The cross was the Christians' symbol during the crusades, inquisitions, and the Holocaust, when six million Jews were killed by Nazi's wearing the iron cross. Unfortunately, the majority of Christians remained silent.

How could Christians have become such an instrument of destruction towards the Jewish people? In these last days, the church must have a revelation of the Jewish people's prophetic role in the unfolding, redemptive purposes of God. The Body of Christ must understand and rightly apply the Scriptures relating to God's covenantal plans for the land of Israel and His chosen people.

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Will the church harden its heart and repeat the same mistakes of the past, or will she learn from her errors, recognize her sin, and repent? Only by repenting will the Church experience the healing, restoration, and reconciliation that God desires — for Israel and the Church.

"Enlarge your house; build an addition. Spread out your home and spare no expense!" 1

While the world is "putting the squeeze" on Israel, attempting to *diminish* her presence, The Sovereign LORD is engaged in *increasing* His people on the land.² That means a strong and steady flow of *Aliyah*. Who do you think will win this grand wrestling match?

Pressure, pressure, pressure, . . . unrelenting pressure upon believers. We know it on a personal level. The ultimate goal is to squeeze out our faith, light, life, love, joy, and effective prayer.

But our Redeemer is strong! He is much stronger than our opponent. Our Redeemer allows our adversary to exert pressure in order to show Himself stronger in and through us.

"I will run the course of Your commandments, for You shall enlarge my heart."

There is no doubt in the Psalmist's mind: "You SHALL enlarge my heart." The Hebrew word for enlarge is "rachab", Strong's #7337. It is a primary root word that means "to broaden,

make room, make open." God is perfectly capable of enlarging our heart even under tremendous pressure from our foe. Hear this word with faith; even only a mustard seed of faith is enough.

With our own hearts enlarged, we rise up in fervent and effective prayer against the pressures of the world trying to "pin Israel". We are not squeezed out by any of the political lies and accusations lobbied against her; nor are we squeezed into dismay or paralysis by the weapons — economic, kinetic, legal, etc. — formed against her. Our faith is enlarged to comprehend and apprehend His glorious work of *Aliyah* now and going forward.

CHOOSE THIS DAY WHOM YOU WILL TRUST

... I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Heaven's Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!" Then I heard the Lord asking, "Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?" I said, "Here I am. Send me."

Isaiah 6:1, 3, 8 NLT

he theme of Isaiah is God's command that the Jewish people trust in Him alone. His message was that, if they continued to serve two masters — Yahweh and the false god — they would fall under the judgment of God. The ten tribes refused to submit to the prophet's call to repent for their abominations. Jerusalem, under the leadership of Isaiah and King Hezekiah, eventually repented and put their trust in God alone.

The Name of God is the "Lord of Hosts, the Commander of the Heavenly Armies." Isaiah 6 made it clear that if His people trusted in the Lord of Hosts as their King, God would protect and deliver them from the Assyrian Empire. The Lord of Hosts miraculously saved Jerusalem by destroying the Assyrian army and killing their king. John 12 tells us that the Lord of Hosts — Jesus Christ — is the Messiah. Isaiah saw our Lord in his glorious vision in the temple.

WILL WE TRUST IN THE LORD OF HOSTS OR COMPROMISE WITH THE WORLD AND ITS FALSE GODS?

Our challenge today is the same as Isaiah's day. Will we trust in the Lord of Hosts or compromise with the world and its false gods?

Our answer must be to trust in the Lord of Hosts — Jesus Christ. What does this mean for us today? In Matthew 25 Jesus tells us we will be judged as nations and as individuals in how we respect and honor "the least of these" — the Jewish people. We are to be their defenders, not their persecutors. We are to bless them, as stated in Genesis 12. The history of the Bible tells us to bless Israel, for out of the descendants of Abraham will come his Seed, our Savior — the Lord of Hosts.

y wife and I made Aliyah in 1996 with four of our six children — ages 1,3,5, and 14. Our two oldest — ages 18 and 21 — made last-minute decisions to stay stateside for various personal reasons.

We had heard from the Lord, and we knew He was calling us to Israel. Even though the Lord clearly spoke to us, it was not an easy decision. The decision to go would have been almost impossible without the Lord's direction. Herein lies the challenge for the typical Jewish person today contemplating *Aliyah*. Without knowing the Lord, the decision factors come down to finances, safety, and "leaving the comforts of home".

Just a few years prior to moving to Israel, we had absolutely no desire to even visit Israel, let alone move! Satan does not want Jewish people to move to Israel, and he will do whatever it takes to prevent that from happening; the reason: God's promise to bring back the Jewish people from the four corners of the earth (Isaiah 11:12)! Satan is trying his best to destroy God's promises.

All over the United States and around the world, everyone is very concerned about the huge uptick in instances of Jewish hatred, which is at levels never seen before! We believe that *Aliyah* is just one of many ways that God has turned evil

into good. We believe the focus of our prayers needs to be for God to transform the hearts and minds of Jewish people, so they see Israel as the safe haven that God has promised and is providing for them. This will take much prayer and intercession!

Making Aliyah is never an easy move. But it is one that brings transformation! It brings a richness and a depth of faith in God to a level not previously experienced. In 2024, 31,000 people representing 100 countries made Aliyah! In Israel we will receive with open arms those who make Aliyah! It will not be an easy adjustment, but it will make all of us more resilient and stronger.

Gentiles, especially the Church, have an enormous calling from God to help with the Aliyah process. (KJV) "No Jew Left Behind" is the title of an Orthodox Jewish song. The title should be our goal. Let's make it happen together!
